Leader Tip

In this series as we explore the role of the Holy Spirit, let's be open to what the Holy Spirit may want to do in our group. Let's be intentional to listen, to wait, to pray and to celebrate stories together.

If someone in your group hasn't felt the presence of the Holy Spirit before or been baptised in the Spirit, take time to pray for them together that they would be filled with the Holy Spirit. Feel free to pray for them to speak in tongues. If you're not sure how to lead in this, get in touch with your cluster leader or check the attached information.

Start Talking:

Ask the group to describe a time when they experienced the Holy Spirit's presence or guidance.

Start Thinking:

When you think of the Holy Spirit what words come to mind to describe him? How can an intimate friendship with the Holy Spirit impact your daily life?

Start Sharing:

Share with the group any misconceptions or fears you've had about the Holy Spirit. Where did those ideas originate, and how do you view the Holy Spirit at this point in your life?

What is something from your past or present that has held, or is holding you back from going "all in" with the Holy Spirit? Discuss what you think it means to go "all in"?

Start Praying:

As we come to pray, read Jeremiah 29:13. Bring those things that hold you back from being "all in" before the Holy Spirit, take some time to be still in God's presence and wait on the Holy Spirit to move. Make space to hear God's voice and share that with one another.

Start Doing:

Commit this week to spending time every day being still in God's presence, waiting on the Holy Spirit. Listen for His voice as He teaches and guides you. Take a step forward in obedience based on His guidance.
