## **START TALKING** - Find conversations starters for the group or with a friend.

If you could choose how you are remembered when you die what would you like people to remember?

## **KEEP READING** - Read the Scripture and ask a question to get the group thinking.

Read: Isaiah 54:2, Psalm 112:5-6

Pastor Carl shared that while shaking may happen around us we can be those who are not shaken and Psalm 112 gives us a formula for doing just that.

- What is the formula that Psalm 112 suggests to us and why do you think this will prevent you being shaken.
- Why is it important for our lives to have purpose and if they don't have purpose what do you think will happen as a result?

## **KEEP TALKING** - Choose questions to create openness.

What we do on earth affects eternity and in eternity we will all have to give an account of ourselves before God (Romans 14:10-12). There are two questions we will be asked:1. What did we do with God's son, Jesus? 2. What did we do with what God gave us?These two questions have a profound impact on our lives now and in eternity.

- How would you answer those two questions?
- Why do think these two questions are the questions we'll be asked?

Pastor Carl shared that we need to be intentional about how we live and what we do with what we have:

- Intentionally give what we have
- Intentionally serve others
- Intentionally share Christ

- What gifts do you have that you can use to make a difference? If someone is unsure in the group take a moment to let them know what gifts you think they have.
- Jesus came to serve, not be served. In what ways can you serve and contribute to the life of the church?
- Sharing Christ is the greatest thing we can ever do (2 Cor 5:20). Who are you sharing Christ with?

#### **KEEP MOVING/GOING** -Commit to a step and live it out this week.

Take a moment to 'Ask God' how you should respond and be intentional about how you live your life and leave a legacy that outlives you.

#### **KEEP PRAYING**

• Take some time this week to pray and why not encourage one another by asking God to give you a word of encouragement for someone in your group.
