START TALKING - Find conversations starters for the group or with a friend.

Have you ever recieved an inheritance from someone? What was that like? inheritance isn't always related to money - what else does it relate to?

KEEP READING - Read the Scripture and ask a question to get the group thinking.

Psalm 112:6 and Hebrews 6:10

Pastor Carl shared that legacy is what people remember when we're gone but also what God remembers when we're gone.

- What stands out to you from the scriptures you read?
- What does legacy mean to you and why is it an important subject to talk about?
- What kind of legacy do you think God wants you to leave?

KEEP TALKING - Choose questions to create openness.

In Isaiah 54:2, it says to "enlarge the place of your tent..." and over the 100 years of Letchworth Garden City Church, it's greatest moments of enlargement have come when we've focussed on others. In fact, what we do for ourselves usually dies with us but what we do for others lives beyond us.

- Why is "others" such an important part of living a life of legacy as a follower of Jesus?
- What does it look like for us to enlarge our hearts and make room for others?

Pastor Carl shared that legacy people:

- have an eternal mindset (John 4:35, 2 Cor 4:18)
- understand sacrifice(Mt 6:19-20)
- have a sense of urgency (Eph 5:15-16)

- Is there anything about being a person of legacy that stands out to you whether as an encouragement or challenge?
- What can you do today in order to be a person of legacy?

In a relay race, everyone run's and everyone get to hold the baton. As a church, this is our time to hold the baton. How will we run? How will we live in our time with the baton in our hand and make the most of the opportunity?

KEEP MOVING/GOING -Commit to a step and live it out this week.

What can you do today to be a person of legacy? Encourage one another to take a step and make a difference.
