## START TALKING - Find conversations starters for the group or with a friend.

What is the strangest mode of transport you have ever taken? Where were you when you took it?

## **KEEP READING** - Read the Scripture and ask a question to get the group thinking.

#### Read Matthew 21:1-11

Craig shared about how Jesus was able to tell the disciples *what* they would find (Donkey and Colt), *where* they would find them (The village ahead of them), *what* they would be asked and *how* they should respond. Jesus shows attention to detail and is intersted in the small details in our lives. He has numbered the hairs on our head (Luke 12:7), He cares about our worries (1 Peter 5:7) and He wants all of our prayers (Phil 4:6).

- What stood out to you from the message?
- What does it mean for God to be interested in the small details of our lives?
- Do you find it easy to continually involve Jesus in the small details of your life?
- How do you respond when you don't see answers to those small prayers?

### **KEEP TALKING** - Choose questions to create openness.

#### Read Mark 8:11-12

God's kingdom is often described as the "Upside Down Kingdom," where power is displayed in service rather than stregnth, in humilty rather than prestige. Jesus came to announce his kingdom, rather than overthrow the Romans as the crowds had hoped. The crowds expectations caused them to miss out on what Jesus was coming to do.

- How do our lives look different when we are living as part of God's Kingdom?
- Why is Salvation the biggest miracle God can ever do in your life?
- In what ways did Jesus demonstrate a different kind of power?
