The Pattern | Honouring Others

START TALKING - Find conversations starters for the group or with a friend.

Joseph asked us a great question, if you met yourself and spent time with yourself, would you look forward to it?

What do you think others would say about spending time with you? How can we be the kind of people that others look forward to being with.

KEEP READING - Read the Scripture and ask a question to get the group thinking.

Romans 12:9-21,

Our value isn't based on what is around us, but who we are and how we reflect the image of Christ.

How do we apply that to ourselves?

How do we apply that others?

KEEP TALKING - Choose questions to create openness.

Joseph gave us 3 reasons we honour others

1. Because they are created in Christ's image
2. Because God calls us to do good works
3. Because God honours people

Do we find it easy or difficult to honour others? Where we are struggling how might the above help us?

KEEP MOVING/GOING -Commit to a step and live it out this week.

Joseph then gave us four ways we are called to honour others. From the list below, what do you find easy or hard and why?

- We love them [without hypocrisy](Romans 12:9)
- We are kind (Romans 12:10) - remember the Rabbit Effect!
- We bless them (Romans 12:14)
- We prefer others and seek their good (Phil 2:1-3)

Is there an action you need to commit to this week, to help you live out a lifestyle of honouring others?

KEEP PRAYING

- Prayer together as a group and ask God by His spirit to help you show the world His love, by loving others.
- Pray for any prayer requests in the group.
